
Tools required



Wood glue



Utility knife



Rubber mallet



The organizer assembly requires about 120 minutes.
The organizer is designed for no-glue assembly. However, applying some glue on the corner connections will increase trays durability. Due to variances in wood, a rubber mallet or glue might be required to secure the pieces together.

We recommend wood glue or another comparable quick setting, tacky glue.

Assembly tips:



- Use utility knife to cut parts out of the sheets. Panching parts may cause wood splitting.
- Some connections may feel too tight. Use of a rubber mallet is recommended to set the parts on their place.
- Due to the cutting process, some pieces may vary slightly. If the piece is symmetrical reversing it may help
